

**TOWN OF NEWFIELDS BOARD OF SELECTMEN
MEETING MINUTES
TUESDAY, JANUARY 14, 2014**

Call to order at 6:48pm.

The Selectmen reviewed and signed the Town Hall rental for Jan. 18, 2014 from 9am-4pm.

Eric Mikkelsen met with the Board to discuss his upcoming B.S.A. Eagle Scout Project he would like to do. Since he grew up in Newfields, he would like to build a garden shed behind the Library for the Garden Club and inquired if a building permit would be needed. The Selectmen felt as long as the setbacks are met there would not be a problem. Eric was planning on running the Pancake Breakfasts at the Library and the proceeds would go to the Scouts.

Chief Reed asked Eric, along with 5 other scouts, to help with the roadside clean-up in the spring and he would donate \$100.00 to their project.

Michael made a motion to accept and approve the Eagle Scout Project at the Library, seconded by Jamie. All were in favor and the motion passed.

Chief Reed met with the Selectmen to discuss parking situations at the Elementary School, Fire Station and the Library. A reminder will be sent out through the School.

The Selectmen approved the use of the Town Hall on Tuesday afternoons by the Brownies.

Minutes of the Jan. 7th meeting were read. Michael made a motion to accept the minutes as written, seconded by Dave. All were in favor and the motion carried.
