

**TOWN OF NEWFIELDS BOARD OF SELECTMEN  
MEETING MINUTES  
TUESDAY, JULY 08, 2014**

***Call to order at 7:05 pm.***

The Selectmen reviewed and signed:

- Checks Pd 06/27/14: Accts. Pay. Manifest - \$15,036.39

The painting of the front exterior of the Town Hall (triangle above the front door, front door, door trim, and copula) was discussed by the Board. A decision was tabled due to more information and quotes.

The Selectmen discussed the removal of the Deaf Child sign at the request of the owner of the property at 48 Old Lee Rd. Sue will contact the family of child. The removal was approved.

Michael DiCroce met with the Selectmen to discuss his run for County Attorney.

The Hawkers and Peddlers permit application was discussed by the Board. Jamie made a motion to waive the \$50.00 Permit Fee, not seconded. The motion was denied. The application was turned over to the Police Dept. for approval.

The borrowing of tables by residents was discussed by the Board. In order to get permission to borrow tables from the Town Hall, residents will meet with the Selectmen, prior to the date, at a Board of Selectmen's meeting.

The Board reviewed the letter from Rockingham County Conservation District ( REF: 209-25.4) to Larry Shaw, Building Inspector, in regard to fill being placed in wetlands and to examine a graywater disposal area for which no permit was found for 14 Ridge Road. Larry will keep the Board updated.

The Selectmen reviewed the Expenditures for June.

Minutes of the June 17th meeting were read. Chris made a motion to accept the minutes as written, seconded by Michael. All were in favor and the motion carried.

At 8:13 pm , Michael made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Chris. The motion passed with all in favor.
