

**TOWN OF NEWFIELDS BOARD OF SELECTMEN
MEETING MINUTES
TUESDAY, JULY 12, 2016**

Present: Selectmen: Chris Hutchins, Jamie Thompson and Michael Sununu. Others include: Chief Liebenow, Nicole & Jeremiah Vernon and Sue McKinnon.

Call to order at 7:00pm.

The Selectmen reviewed and signed:

At 7:00pm, the Board of Selectmen, by motion of Selectmen Hutchins, seconded by Selectmen Thompson and in accordance with RSA91-A:3(I), to enter into a non-public session for purpose of personnel matter [RSA91-A:3(II)(c)]. At 7:20pm, the Board of Selectmen, by motion of Selectmen Hutchins, in accordance with RSA91-A:3(III), that the minutes will not be disclosed because divulgence of the information would adversely affect the reputation of a person other than a member of the Board or render the proposed action ineffective. All were in favor and the 2/3 requirement for affirmative vote was met.

Jackie Horgan informed the Board about a bright house light at 306 Piscassic Rd which is blinding to drivers coming around the curve.

Jeremiah and Nicole Vernon met with the Selectman to discuss the situations that have taken place with a neighbor.

Sue McKinnon discussed the purchase of the dog sign with the Board, which they approved for the cul-de-sac at Scanlon Way and Heath Drive.

Ben, spokesman for Elaine Williams, gave a letter to Sue, to inform the Selectmen that property was purchased in Epping and he is requesting an extension date of Oct. 1, 2016 to remove the cement slab.

Start Date is needed from Edison Wood Floors for the Town Hall.

Dave Edgerly is waiting for Sue to gather more information before going live with the website. He will be attending August 16th meeting with the site live.
